



Electrical contacts

Most of ENFM's 4" and 6" pressure gauges with a bayonet bezel can be executed with alarm contacts to turn on a signal light, operate a valve or pump, or sound an alarm.

The contacts can easily be set so that a circuit can be closed or opened at a desired pressure temperature. The setting of the contacts can be made in the field without removing the instrument from service.

The magnetically-assisted and inductive contacts can be build in for both dry and liquid filled gauges. Below you find the various contact schedules for the different functions.
